## Confession of Faith ~ Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, begotten from the Father before all ages, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made; of the same essence as the Father.

Through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven; he became incarnate by the Holy Spirit and the virgin Mary, and was made human. He was crucified for us under Pontius Pilate; he suffered and was buried. The third day he rose again, according to the Scriptures. He ascended to heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again with glory to judge the living and the dead. His kingdom will never end.

And we believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life. He proceeds from the Father and the Son, and with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified. He spoke through the prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic church. We affirm one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look forward to the resurrection of the dead, and to life in the world to come. Amen.

O Lord our God and heavenly Father, we confess we are unworthy to appear in your sight. We daily break your holy laws and commandments, although you are our Creator, who made us, and our Redeemer, who bought us with the blood of your only-begotten Son, and our Comforter, who bestows on us holy graces. If you were to deal with us as our wickedness deserves, we could expect shame and confusion in this life and, in the world to come, everlasting condemnation. Yet, O Lord, in the obedience of your commandment, and confident in your endless mercy, we appeal from your throne of justice to your throne of grace, where mercy reigns to pardon abounding sin. From the bottom of our hearts we humbly ask you to forgive our offences and misdeeds. By the virtue of the precious blood of Jesus Christ, may our sins, original and actual, be cleansed, so that they may never have power to rise up in judgment against us.

## Reading of God's Word

### Isaiah 6:1-6

*6 In the year that King Uzziah died I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up; and the train of his robe filled the temple. 7 Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. 8 And one called to another and said:*

*"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts;  
the whole earth is full of his glory!"*

*9 And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke. 10 And I said: "Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!"*

*11 Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. 12 And he touched my mouth and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for."*

### Revelation 5:9-14

*9 And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation, 10 and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on the earth."*

*11 Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, 12 saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!"*

*13 And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea, and all that is in them, saying, "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever!"*

"Christ alone has executed God's plan at the cost of His own blood. He alone is worthy. He is the Lion who conquered, yet He is the Lamb who was slaughtered for sinners. The only way to share in God's victory and kingdom is by trusting in Christ alone. Faith in Christ alone says to Him, 'Thou alone art worthy of my trust.' By God's grace, do you trust Him?

Without Christ, we have cause for nothing but weeping, but with Christ we have reason for nothing but worship. If the angels sing of His worthiness, how much more should sinful men, women, and children bought by His blood give Him their submission, praise, and prayer? How does your life show adoration for Christ? How could you adore Him even more?" - *Family Worship Bible Guide, Joel R. Beeke*

## **Revelation 21:1-7**

*21 Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. 2 And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. 3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. 4 He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.” 5 And he who was seated on the throne said, “Behold, I am making all things new.” Also he said, “Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.” 6 And he said to me, “It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. To the thirsty I will give from the spring of the water of life without payment. 7 The one who conquers will have this heritage, and I will be his God and he will be my son.*
